The Parties shall provide all pesticide application records for the period of July 01, 2005 to July 26, 2006.

and Mr. Semchuk completed remedial action in 2001 and 2003. A routine inspection confirmed signs requesting "fill dirt" posted; indications of recent earth moving activity; numerous piles of materials (the "Waste"), including but not limited to: cardboard, plastic, concrete, aggregate and asphalt, rebar, wood, railway ties, wood waste and brush, animal bedding materials, manure and other garbage and debris at various locations, including in and adjacent to the Lake on the Lands. The placement of fill and waste disposal activities were not confined to the Lands, and extend onto Public Land and have altered, or may become capable of altering, the flow, location and level of water in the Lake. Mr. Semchuk shall immediately cease bringing any Waste or other material on the Lands; immediately cease burying any Waste or other material on the Lands (this prohibition does not extend to inert material used for reclamation purposes); remove all Waste that has been disposed on the Lands and Waste disposed of on adjacent lands; remove all Waste buried on the Lands and dispose at an approved waste management facility; return any areas of the Lands where Waste had been present to the contours that existed on the Lands; and submit a final written report at the completion detailing the work undertaken to comply with this Order.
