An inspection confirmed that there was a large obstruction comprised of soil, woody vegetation and other surface materials that had been constructed within the tributary of Poison Creek without an approval. This caused a blockage in water flow to lower reaches of the tributary stream of Poison Creek, and a threat of flooding to adjacent properties. Ms. Bauman shall submit and implement a Remedial Plan, and submit a final written report detailing the work undertaken to comply with this Order.

On 9 February 2007, the Company plead guilty and was sentenced to a fine of \$6,000.00 and a Creative Sentencing Order in the amount of \$1000.00 directing the Company to publish the facts relating to the conviction in the Calgary Herald.
ConocoPhillips Canada Resources Corp.		07-Mar-07 Penalty: \$220,000.00	AEPEA(R) 109(2)	Count 1: Co-accused "ConocoPhillips Canada Limited, ConocoPhillips Canada (East) Limited, ConocoPhillips Canada (North) Limited, ConocoPhillips Western Canada Partnership and ConocoPhillips Canada Resources Corp. and Wabiskaw Explorations Ltd. carrying on business under the Partnership of ConocoPhillips Canada Energy Partnership" On or between the 6th day of January 2004 and the 12th day of January 2004, at or near Ponoka in the Province of Alberta, did unlawfully release or permit the release into the environment of a substance in an amount, concentration or level or at a rate of release that causes or may cause a significant adverse effect, contrary to section 109(2) of the Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act. Pled guilty 7 March 2007 and sentenced to a penalty in the amount of \$220,000. The penalty consists of a \$20,000 fine and a creative sentencing order in the amount of \$200,000 in favor of the University of Saskatchewan for research into the effects of H2S on livestock.
